
BADEN MASTERS 2020 – CORONAVIRUS SAFETY RULES

In view of the current Corona pandemic, the Organizing Committee shall ensure that all possible sources of infection are minimized and all the rules of the Swiss Government and the Kanton of Aargau are consequently respected. As safety for athletes, coaches, staff and spectators have the highest priority.

Usually in the Baden Masters curling event, athletes and spectators mingle around, the entry door is open to welcome everyone who has interest in the curling sport. However, this year will be a bit different.

Athletes and spectators cannot be mixed. Since 6th of July 2020 the curling rinks in Baden are open. Swiss Curling runs the operation. The rinks are mainly used by the Swiss Elite Teams. This responsibility of Swiss Curling will end by 31st August (end of the Baden Masters). One main rule is not to mix athletes and „others“. Disinfection products are in place, all club members who use the ice rink facilities are required to register themselves to enable contact tracing in case of an infection.

SAFETY RULES BADEN MASTERS

BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT

Most of the teams will arrive on Thursday, 27th August. Some teams travel by car, but most of the foreign teams will be picked up at the airport and are transported to ice rink/players hotel. During the travel from airport to hotel, all persons in the vehicle shall wear the face mask which will be provided by us. Otherwise transport will be refused.

After arrival at the ice rink, athletes and coaches will only be allowed to the ice rink for their training sessions and for their games. During all other times, they are all kindly requested to stay at the players lounge in the hotel or in the hotel rooms.

@the ice rink; There are three locker rooms which can be used (inkl. washroom). The teams having rooms in the Apart Hotel shall change their clothing in the hotel and only change shoes at the Curling Club. Brooms and other Curling equipment have to be taken back to the hotel and cannot be left in the locker rooms. Swiss teams, who are not staying in the athletes Hotel can use the locker rooms, however, they as well shall bring their brooms and other equipment to their cars after each training or game.

Locker Rooms will be cleaned daily.

IDENTIFICATION

All players and their coaches will receive an identification badge. From Friday, 28th August until Sunday, 30st August, a strict access control will be in place – no badge – no entry! Hence, before the start of the tournament we shall receive the listing of each team (athletes and coaches names) for the purpose of contact tracing.

DURING THE TOURNAMENT

We provide disinfection products in all areas. Players clean their stones before starting to play with disinfection product.

Players are not allowed to mix with spectators during the tournament. No access to the restaurant as long as spectators are in the restaurant. We will provide food and beverages in the players' lounge. Players are requested to leave the ice rink immediately after the game.

When playing; coaches and 5th players have reserved seating area in the Restaurant - behind their sheet strictly reserved for them.

SPECTATORS

There is only one common entrance to the ice rink - for athletes and spectators. Restaurant-area; the number of people allowed at any point of time during the whole tournament is 100. This is including coaches, staff, etc. For this reason we are limiting the number of access (spectators) to a maximum of 70 persons.

Spectators will use the same entrance and exit as the players. All must respect the distance of 1.5m. There are two separate washrooms for spectators/staff only (not to be used by athletes/coaches).

At the entry control, spectators must leave their contact data to – in case – enable later contact tracing. They will get a badge – no badge/no entry. Additionally we will provide a mask to all spectators if the distance of 1.5 meters cannot be maintained. The Organising Committee can force the spectators to wear mask, when not eating (same rules as in public transport).

Overall, we kindly ask everybody to respect the basic rules on hygiene and distance.

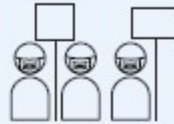

Observe a distance of at least 1.5 metres



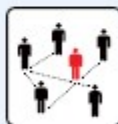
Wear a mask if this distance cannot be observed

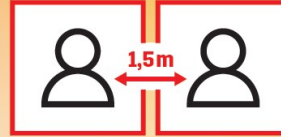
